1 - Text Remind Wabamun School uses Text Remind to keep in contact with families. Text Remind can be set up and used through an App, or you can connect yourself to the teacher by sending the message to the phone number listed. Once connected to the teacher, you will receive messages via the App or by text. If you send a message to the teacher, your message goes only to the teacher and not to the group.

2 - Email Another great method of communication with your child's teacher(s) is via email. Teachers emails all follow this format: firstname.lastname@psd.ca

3 - Newsletters Some teachers use newsletters to keep parents informed of upcoming events, and to celebrate recent events.
